#### 1. PHARMA IDEATHON



## **Objectives:**

• To bring forth future thought leaders, researchers and entrepreneurs in pharmaceutical sciences and healthcare.

#### Rules:

Idea should be novel and that may fall into one of the following categories:

- 1) Idea with technical background 2) Idea with preliminary proof 3) Idea that is fully established
- Maximum 4 members in each team. The team may have Mentor. Idea should be Novel with/without solution. Mode of presentation can be Audio Visual/ Actual model/ Virtual model/ Prototype. Novel ideas will be supported for proof-of concept/prototype building and to convert into start up by GTU Atal Incubation Centre.

Note: Winners of Zonal rounds shall receive information from their respective zones and will have to reregister for the Central Tech Fest Events.

#### 2. CLINICAL CASE STUDY

# **Objectives:**

• This competition will help students to understand and practice Clinical pharmacy. • It will help for critical evaluation of clinical cases.

#### Rules:

• A team consisting of maximum two participants. • A clinical case will be provided to the students one hour before the actual event. During this one hour students can access internet as well as standard books for analyzing the case. • The team will have to present their analysis through power point in maximum ten minutes.

## 3. PHARMA QUIZ

# **Objectives:**

It is a mind sport, in which the student teams attempt to answer questions correctly. It is a game to test general as well as pharma knowledge.

## **Rules:**

• One team per college. • Three students per team. • If the number of entries for this event exceeds four, elimination round will be conducted using MCQs based examination. • The first four teams will be selected for final event. • Decision of judges will be considered as final

# 4. PHARMA DEBATE

# **Objectives:**

• To create awareness regarding current pharma affairs. • To generate effective thinking into issues in the given topic • To add value to the communication skills of an individual. • To boost up logical thinking ability.

## **Rules:**

- A team consists of two participants. Top 3 teams from each zone would be given entry. Central Techfest round: Maximum 5 teams per institute.
- Duration: Ten minutes. Medium of expression will be Hindi or English. Topic for the event will be announced 24 hours in advance.
- Paper reading is not allowed. Use of foul language and aggression is not allowed.





#### **5.PHARMA POSTER PRESENTATION**



# **Objectives:**

- It will help to gain and update knowledge regarding publications and current advancement in the pharmaceutical sciences.
- It is a good way to enhance the creativity and clarity of one's ideas. Participants can enhance their presentation skills.

#### **Rules:**

• The topic for the poster is restricted to recent advancements in pharma field. • There should be max 3 participants allowed per poster. • Central Techfest: 10 entries per institute. • The area provided for poster presentation is 1 sq.m (3 x 3 Feet). • The title of the poster should cover full width of the poster. • The title should be brief informative and written in bold letter. • The names of the author address should be written below the title in small letters but presenting author must be present. • The size of the letter should be such that a viewer can read it from 2 m distance. • The message should be clear, understandable and self-explanatory. • The participant/s should remain present at the place allotted to them throughout the display period. • Faculty Mentor is allowed.

Note: The abstract has to be submitted on pharmcrenova@gtu.edu.in on or before 15th March.
