NAME OF EVENT: The Mine -Field - "Zara Sun ke Chalo"

NO. OF MAX. PARTICIPANTS: The participants can participate in a group of 2 members

ABSTRACT:

A fun activity which involves trust and teamwork promoting to a serious environment and encouraging them to become active listeners.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

The Team will consist of 2 players.

1) Elimination Round:

- Solve a crossword puzzle to compete in the qualifier round (+2) for every right answer & (-1) for every wrong answer.
- Top 10 teams (based on the scores in the elimination round) will be competing in the qualifier round.
- Additional question related to HR practices for tie-breaking situation & the team with the correct answer will proceed accordingly.







2) Qualifier Round:

The Team with high negative scores will get eliminated (i.e. minimum negative points will lead to selection for the finale round)

- The goal of the team is to get from one side of the minefield to the other (the starting point and the ending point will be marked on the minefield)
- Maximum time allotted to each team to cross the minefield is 15 minutes.
- Out of the 2 players, one will be blindfolded who will be standing inside the minefield, however, will not be allowed to see or talk. The other player will be allowed to see and talk but will neither be allowed the blindfolded teammate nor enter the minefield.
- The player outside the minefield has to verbally guide his/her blindfolded teammate to cross the minefield full of obstacles. The blindfolded teammates is not allowed to touch any obstacle coming his/her way.
- At a time, 2 individual team will be playing the game led by 2 coordinators for each team.
- The team scores a negative point each when blindfolded teammate; (i) touches any
 obstacle (ii) steps outside the minefield (iii) opens blindfold without crossing the field (iv)
 speaks (v) argues with the coordinator.
- The team scores a negative point each when teammate outside the minefield; (i) touches the blindfolded teammate (ii) steps inside the minefield (iii) touches any obstacles inside the minefield (iv) argue with the coordinator.
- Top 2 teams (based on the scores in the qualifier round) will be competing in the finale round.
- Teams will compete against each other for tie-breaking situation

3) Finale Round:

- The team with minimum negative points will be declared as a "winner" and the opponent team will be declared as "Runner-up"
- The decision of the coordinator will be final and binding.
